The rates are for the academic year 2025-2026. Rates shown are for **single bedrooms and shared bathrooms per individual**. All students living in housing must provide a **\$300 pre-payment** at the time of application which covers a \$150 refundable deposit and a \$150 administrative fee (application and programming fee).

*Damages are assessed at the end of each occupancy or academic year and applied to the student account. Wherever possible individual amounts will be assessed, however, damage assessments may be split between students in common areas. Assessments will be limited to the total cost of parts and labor. The damage deposit will be maintained on the student account until the final semester of occupancy and refunded minus any balance owed to the College. A damage deposit may also be refunded by an applicant if the housing request is canceled and requested by July 1, December 1, or May 1 before the semester of occupancy.
