Student Housing 2026-2027

All students living in housing must provide a \$300 pre-payment at time of application which covers \$150 refundable deposit and a \$150 administrative fee (application and programming fee). Room rates are based on the academic calendar and cover the weekend prior to start of fall/spring/summer semester through the last day of the semester. Students are subject to additional charges if allowed to stay between semesters.

*Damages are assessed at the end of each occupancy or academic year and applied to the student account. Wherever possible individual amounts will be assessed, however damage assessments may be split between students in common areas. Assessments will be limited to total cost of parts and labor. The damage deposit will be maintained on the student account until the final semester of occupancy and refunded minus any balance owed to the College. Damage deposit may also be refunded by an applicant if the housing request is cancelled and requested by July 1, December 1, or May 1 prior to the semester of occupancy.

Food Services Meal Plan Addition for FY27 Fee Schedule

Daily rates locked in rate that customers at full-service food service locations can pay at the cashier. Semester plans are allowed to be added to a student's account and considered part of the student's total education expense, payable with excess financial aid or payment plans.
